I started reading the book of Jonah today, and right from the start, I saw myself in his story. I've never been called to go to Nineveh, but there have been days when I'm called to make amends with someone I've hurt. Whether I'm right or I'm wrong, I know that the best thing to do is to follow the Spirit which tells us to do all that we can to live in peace with each other.

The flesh is a difficult thing to combat some days as I wrestle with fear, the fear of being rejected, of being shut out, of feeling less than. But when I obey the Spirit in spite of my fear, the rewards outweigh the pain. It might take courage to follow God's will, but with each step we take we strengthen our faith.

Each day comes with its own set of challenges and opportunities to follow God's will, but even when the Spirit is willing the flesh has a mind of its own. It tends to resist, make excuses, or fill our minds with doubt and fear.
